
INSTALLATION SEQUENCE

- 1. ADHERE PERIMETER ISOLATION BOARD (PIB) TO WALLS.
- 2. ROLL OUT RIM ISOLATION SYSTEM.
- 3. INSTALL 'HIGH LOAD" PADS WHERE SHOWN ON DRAWINGS.
 TO INSTALL, CUT AWAY LOW DENSITY FIBER GLASS AND INSTALL
 KIP PAD "TOP." SIDE UP. A DAB OF CONSTRUCTION ADHESIVE
 ON THE BOTTOM WILL HOLD THE PAD IN PLACE.
- 4. OPTIONAL: WOOD NAILERS LAID ON TOP OF THE PADS. IF SHOWN ON DRAWINGS, THE FIRST LAYER OF PLYWOOD SHOULD BE SCREWED INTO THE WOOD NAILERS.

- 5. LAY FIRST LAYER OF PLYWOOD OUT STAGGERING JOINTS, BUTTING LIGHTLY TO PIB (PERIMETER ISOLATION BOARD)
- 6. ROLL OUT ROOFING PAPER (OPTIONAL)
- 7. LAY SECOND LAYER OF PLYWOOD 90 DEGREES TO FIRST LAYER, STAGGERING AND OVERLAPPING ALL JOINTS.
- 8. SCREW PLYWOOD LAYERS TOGETHER WITH 1" SCREWS ON 8" CENTERS BOTH DIRECTIONS.
- 9. INSTALL FINISHED FLOOR AS PER MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS.
